

1.01 Warren County WIFFLE Ball (WCWB) is a gentleman's game in which to have fun, drink beer, eat, and win.

A TRADITIONAL PRACTICE or CUSTOM occurs when two teams CANNOT AGREE if a runner is safe or out and only then. The two players involved in the play will participate in the traditional practice or custom.

No bat or ball modifications. Original WIFFLE brand bats and balls used.

You may peg a player running between bases.

A STRIKE is a legal pitch which;

- (a) Is obviously struck at by the batter and is missed;
- (b) Is not struck at, and hits the strike zone;
- (c) Is fouled by the batter when he has less than two strikes;
- (d) Touches the batter as he strikes at it;
- (e) Touches the batter in flight in the strike zone; or
- (f) Becomes a foul tip.

For the portion highlighted in red. Please be accountable. Accountability is also extremely important on check swings.

A batted ball that stops moving in the triangle in front of home plate is a foul. Such a batted ball on a 3<sup>rd</sup> strike results in a strikeout, as does a foul tip into the strike zone.

A runner cannot leave a base until the ball crosses the plate.

No pinch runners or batters. No DH. Only 5 batters in a game lineup.

During an inning, a pitcher may be substituted for another player currently on the field only.

Substitutions may be made between innings and should be announced. Player B may enter the game for Player A. Player A may re-enter the game between innings in place of Player B. Player B may not re-enter.

No Dogs Allowed.

Protesting calls. If a team cannot come to a resolution within three minutes the WCWBC will make a ruling. WCWBC reserves final judgment.

Please ensure that you and your players get home safely from the tournament.
