HOLD HARMLESS FORM/MEDICAL FORM

All forms were filled out online at the time of registration. This includes your waiver and medical information.

CHECK IN:

You will check in on Monday July 6th between 1:00pm – 2:30 pm at the Perry Fieldhouse located at 801 N. Mercer Rd. At 2:45pm there will be a player/parent meeting to go over details of the week. It is not mandatory that parents attend this meeting.

A Zoom meeting will be held on June 11th at 7:00pm EST which will cover the same details. Below is the link:

Please leave your personal belongings and hockey equipment in your car when checking in. Only bring in your helmet so we can put your first name on the front and back of the helmet.

Airport Transportation (Without Assistance)

For those of you who are flying in and need transportation to and from the airport, please email Chase Simms csimms@bgsu.edu to give your flight information. There is a \$50 charge each way if you fly by yourself and can be picked up and dropped off at the baggage claim without assistance. This will be a separate fee paid later (not when you are registering for the camp). The airport is Detroit Metro Airport. Upon arriving, we will meet you in the baggage claim area.

Note: Each airline has an age requirement that allows someone to fly by themselves. We will only meet players in the baggage claim area. We cannot meet them at the gate at arrival or departure. Please check with your airline to make sure they can fly alone.

We would like your arrival time at the airport to be by 1:30pm on Monday July 6th. We would prefer all departures on July 11th to be after 2:30pm.

HOUSING AND MEALS:

You will be housed in a dormitory located near the ice arena. **If you are flying:** Towels, pillows, and linens will be provided. **If you are driving,** you will need to bring your own sheets, pillow, towels etc. a sleeping bag is recommended because it is easy, and the dormitory is air-conditioned. We request that you limit any electronic devices you bring. If you do have a cell phone or electronic device, they must always remain in your dorm room. We are not responsible for lost or damaged appliances or any type of electronic devices.

Since this is a USA Hockey camp, you will be given a random roommate.

All meals are included in the cost of the camp and will be at the BGSU dining facility. If anyone has any dietary restrictions, you will have put that in your online registration form, but you can also email Chase Simms (see email address above).
