# Tryouts & Team Formation: 8/11 – 8/20 - What to Expect

- Tryouts start on first day and teams are formed by last day
  - Day 1: Player Meeting at 8:30am in the Lecture Hall, then Fitness Testing until 11am; 1-3pm Training
  - Coaches group the players into practice groups by end of day on 8/12
  - Training during the first week is how coaches assess players for teams
  - Teams are announced by coaches along with uniform handout by 8/19
- Training locations and times can change based on weather, coach discretion, etc.
  - **Changes are communicated to the PLAYERS first from Coaches or Captains via GroupMe chat**
  - *Boosters attempt to keep up with schedule changes on the website, but your player should know first*

After Varsity team is identified, all remaining players are placed by grade level first and then spread throughout the teams as the numbers and skills are assessed.
