Budget-

- \$11,979.64 is currently in the account with one outstanding check to the church.
- Mark made a request for 12 months of statements from the bank to help with reconciling the club account.
- Coach's shirts were removed as an item line in the budget. The club will be paying the US Lacrosse fees for each coach, and coaches will have the option to purchase their own club apparel.
- Currently there is a \$2,000.00 Indoor Rental line. Yellow Breeches has been reserved starting November 27, 2017. It is reserved every Monday. It was discussed that we could hold additional clinics for new players and divide the time between age groups for additional practice time after the holidays.

Registration

- First registration will be held November 14, 2017 6:00-8:00 PM.
- Board Members were asked to help run registration night and bring lap tops to help with registrations.
- Girls will need a copy of their report cards and boys will need birth certificates for the night of registration.
- Players who have not returned their uniforms from a previous year must do so at registration or pay a \$100 uniform fee.
- Online Registration will be open soon.
- Pricing was voted on and approved. The pricing is as follows:
 - Registration** \$155.00 for the first player
 - \$105.00 for the second player
 - \$75.00 for the third player
 - Mandatory Buyout-** The buyout must be paid before the team's first spring practice (if not doing the fundraiser).
 - \$30.00 for the first player
 - \$50.00 for the entire family
- Precision will be setting up a table at registration with different lax gear for sale.

501c3

- Raphelle is beginning the application process immediately
- It will cost approximately \$450.00
- The turnaround time to receive the 501c3 status will be 3-4 weeks.
