

DIVISION 1 WBCA TOP 20 - MAY 11, 2026

With many teams still trying to catch up on getting rain outs and snow outs made up, there still is a wide variety in games played from teams throughout different regions of the State. Germantown remained perfect and is in firm control of the Greater Metro. The 3rd of five WBCA Division 1 polls featured moving week in the Fox Valley Association, as Kimberly went 4-0, including tight wins against Appleton North and Hortonville... with both those clubs dropping a 2nd FVA game during the week. Muskego has rallied after a slow start to their season and is now in firm control of the Classic Eight Conference. Bay Port has a four game lead over DePere in the Fox River Classic and moves up to 5th in the poll, while the Redbirds crack the poll, coming in at #18. West Bend West is the only other D1 team with a perfect record and moves up a spot to #9. Milton is tied with Beaver Dam and a game ahead of Monona Grove in the Badger Large, despite sporting a much better overall record which has them moving up a spot to 8th even though

they dropped a non-conference game to a sudden resurgent Sun Prairie East squad that comes in at 10th and seems to have to put early season losses behind them. Verona remains right on their heels and four other teams will still have a say in the race. Franklin moved up a spot to 6th but will be tested by rival Kenosha Tremper who comes in at 13th with three games played between the two schools the next five days.
