USHL Futures Camp (2006 and 2007 Born Players Only)

June 11th to June 13th, 2021

The Tri-City Storm Futures Camp will be held June 11th to the 13th, 2021.

The Tri-City Storm Futures Camp will be held at the Las Vegas Ice Center located at 9295 West Flamingo Road #130 Las Vegas, Nevada 89147.

This exposure camp is open to players 14 and 15 years old (2006 and 20067 born only).

There is a **\$400.00** Futures Camp Registration Fee for this (on-line registration only).

Camp spots will be filled on a first come / first served basis until the camp is full.

The camp format includes two games, one position and one team practice, and seminars for all participants.

The Tri-City Storm will use this camp to evaluate 2006 and 2007 born goaltenders and skaters for the USHL's 2022 and 2023 Phase I and Phase II Drafts and beyond which will take place in May 2022 and May 2023 when those players will be officially eligible to be drafted by a USHL club in that year's Phase One USHL Draft.

During the camp, the Storm will host daily seminars to all camp players and their parents regarding information on junior hockey, the USHL, and most importantly the Storm on how the team and league operates as well as specifics on how the Storm run their day to day hockey operations. There will also be a Question and Answer session available to all parents on the final day with Storm staff members.

This is a great opportunity for players who are not eligible or ready (age wise) for the USHL and the junior hockey level to experience an extremely competitive camp, become familiar with one of the top developmental programs in the country, meet the Storm hockey staff, and show their potential for following seasons.

The Storm host hotel for the 2021 Futures Camp will be announced and information available at a later date.

It is advised that all players come in good physical condition in order to perform well in this competition. The three days will be competitive and tiring.

Participating players will receive a detailed schedule via email at least one week prior to the camp.

The camp facility and host hotel will meet all necessary state and government safety requirements necessary.

If the camp dates must be cancelled or changed on behalf of the team – full refunds of the registration fees for the camp will be provided to registered participants.
