## 2021 Travel Soccer Info Guide

### Seasons

MSL plays three seasons through the year, Spring (April through June) Fall (August through November) and Winter indoor season (dates will vary). Our seasons overlap with the seasons of other sports, so please plan accordingly!

### Time Commitment

For the duration of the two main seasons (Spring and Fall), practices will occur two times weekly. These practice days will be decided by the coaches, but usually fall on weeknights.

Games are primarily on Sundays for the duration of the season and should take priority over involvement in other sports or activities not deemed "school" activities. Events and activities that are put on by the schools will be scheduled around when possible.

Travel Soccer is a larger time commitment at a higher skill level than Rec Soccer, and will involve more dedication from the parents/guardians and more practice time for the players. Players who do not attend the majority of practices may have a deduction in play time if deemed appropriate by their coach.

### Area of Play

Games will be both home and away. Depending on what division each team plays in, the travel distance will vary. Most teams play in divisions that have games around 1 hour drive time distance, but the teams in each division change yearly.

### Player Fees

Fees are collected yearly and are subject to change as prices fluctuate. As of 2021, yearly fees are \$180

Fees DO include coverage for : Spring Season, Fall Season, Winter season, US Soccer Club Player Passes (good for 1 year of play competitively), Entrance to one tournament yearly.

Fees DO NOT include coverage for : Player's uniforms (updated uniforms are required for play), Player's cleats/shin guards/goalie equipment/etc.
