At a Press conference today, October 6, 2020, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf released the following Amendment to the "Directing Mitigation Measures", a copy of which is attached. The Amendment permits and allows an increase in operation to the respective facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. USA Hockey events will be sanctioned by the Mid-American District Hockey, Inc the affiliate so long as they comply with the Governor's directive.

**AMENDMENT TO THE ORDER OF
THE GOVERNOR OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
DIRECTING TARGETED MITIGATION MEASURES**

I hereby amend my Order "Directing Mitigation Measures" dated July 15, 2020.

Section 3 is amended to replace Subsections (A) and (B) as follows:

(A) Venues hosting events or gatherings must determine their established occupancy limit as defined by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Life Safety Code and then apply the attendee calculator to determine how many attendees are permitted to attend the event or gathering.

i. Maximum Occupancy Calculator for indoor events:

<i>Maximum Occupancy</i>	<i>Allowable Indoor Rate</i>
<i>0 - 2,000 people</i>	<i>20% of Maximum Occupancy</i>
<i>2,001 - 10,000 people</i>	<i>15% of Maximum Occupancy</i>
<i>Over 10,000 people</i>	<i>10% of Maximum Occupancy up to 3,750 people</i>

ii. Maximum Occupancy Calculator for outdoor events:

<i>Maximum Occupancy</i>	<i>Allowable Outdoor Rate</i>
<i>0 - 2,000 people</i>	<i>25% of Maximum Occupancy</i>
<i>2,001 - 10,000 people</i>	<i>20% of Maximum Occupancy</i>
<i>Over 10,000 people</i>	<i>15% of Maximum Occupancy up to 7,500 people</i>

(B) When no fire code capacity is published or available for outdoor events or gatherings venues, establish occupancy as 67 people per 1000 square feet and then apply the maximum occupancy calculator. Venues may also contact their local building code officials if they are unaware of their occupancy limit.

Section 3 is amended to add Subsection E:

(E) Venues must require attendees to comply with six-foot social distancing requirements, to wear masks or face coverings in compliance with the Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health Requiring Universal Face Coverings, and implement best practices such as timed entry, multiple entry and exit points, multiple restrooms and hygiene stations. The Order as previously amended otherwise remains unchanged.

This Amendment is effective October 9, 2020, and enforcement of the Amended Order will commence on October 9, 2020.
