HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 1.5 cumulative GPA
- Meets promotion standard (View promotion standards at <http://bit.ly/wcpsspromotion>)
- Passes a minimum of 75% of the courses during the previous semester
 - Note: The “previous semester” for Fall sports is spring of the previous school year. The “previous semester” for Spring sports is fall of the current school year. Winter sports must meet the eligibility requirements for fall sports to try out and begin the season, and meet the eligibility requirements for spring sports to maintain eligibility after the end of first semester.
 - Students at BHS must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 courses to compete
- Attend class a minimum of 85% of the school year
- Does not turn 19 years old prior to August 31 of the school year
- Has not been convicted of a felony

COLLEGE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Division I and II eligibility requirements are set by the NCAA. Division III schools have eligibility criteria set by the individual schools and their conferences.

DIVISION I

Division I eligibility is based on a core GPA and a corresponding ACT/SAT score based on a sliding scale. The minimum core GPA (with corresponding test score) for competition is a 2.3. Ten core courses will be “locked” in at the end of 11th grade. Seven of the ten courses must be in English, Math, and Science. The core GPA is computed using the following:

- 4 English credits
- 3 Math credits (Math 1 or higher)
- 2 Science credits
- 1 additional credit in English, Math, or Science
- 2 Humanities credits
- 4 additional credits in English, Math, Science, Humanities, or World Languages.

DIVISION II

Division II eligibility is based on a core GPA and a corresponding ACT/SAT score based on a sliding scale. The minimum core GPA (with corresponding test score) for competition is a 2.2. The core GPA is computed using the following:

- 3 English credits
- 2 Math credits (Math 1 or higher)
- 2 Science credits
- 3 additional credit in English, Math, or Science
- 2 Humanities credits
- 4 additional credits in English, Math, Science, Humanities, or World Languages.
