



Coach Code of Conduct

1. Sportsmanship expectations:

All people associated with the game of lacrosse are always expected to act with sportsmanship, teamwork, dignity, and respect for others. This includes coaches, parents, players, and referees.

Poor Sportsmanship includes:

- *Arguing with coaches, officials, teammates, opponents, or spectators
- *Using threatening or profane language
- *Baiting or taunting coaches, officials, teammates, opponents, or spectators
- *Unsafe play
- *Uncontrolled or disrespectful behavior during practices or on sidelines in the bench area

2. Code of Conduct requirement:

All coaches must sign both the USA Lacrosse Code of Conduct as well as the WYLO Code of Conduct in order to participate.

3. Consequences:

Failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct during games or practices will result in the following:

First Offense: Sit out of ½ of one game

Second Offense: Will not be able to participate with the team for 1 week (This includes games and practices) A meeting will be held with parents, player, and board.

Third Offense: Dismissal from team for remainder of season.
