## **Board Members Responsibilities**

**President:** The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board. The President shall in general supervise the activities of the Association, review the annual Form 990 filing, and perform such other duties as the Board may prescribe. The President may sign contracts and other agreements on behalf of the Association. The President will be the Board Member represented at the CAHA meetings.

**Vice President:** The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in his or her absence, review the annual Form 990 filing, and such other duties as the Board or President may prescribe.

**Secretary:** The Secretary shall take attendance at all meetings of the Board. The Secretary shall see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; shall see that minutes of all Board meetings are prepared and ratified; review the annual Form 990 filing, shall serve as official custodian of the Association's records; and may attest to the signature of the President or Vice President, as the case may be. The Secretary shall in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the Board.

**Treasurer:** The Treasurer shall be the principal financial officer of the Association. The Treasurer shall review periodic financial statements; present the financial statements to the Board; review the annual Form 990 filing; and perform all other duties incident to the office of the Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or the Board.

**Hockey Director:** The Hockey Director shall be the principal contact for CAHA scheduling meetings, ice time, try-outs, coaching staff and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or the Board.

- All players must be registered with USA Hockey
- Registration through SportsNgin opened August 20<sup>th</sup> on our website [www.grandjunctioncoyotes.com](http://www.grandjunctioncoyotes.com)
- All players must be registered by **October 1<sup>st</sup>** to be on the ice and ready to play by on October 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Late registrations are subject to delayed ice time practice
- All players must have the GJ Coyotes Jerseys to play in games
- All players must have the GJ Coyotes practice jerseys for practice

## **Mandatory Jersey and Equipment Requirements**

Mites/Squirts/PeeWee/Bantam: Each Player must have a white and black practice jersey.

Squirts/PeeWee/Bantam: Each Player must have a white and black game jersey and game socks

**\*\* If you are purchasing new equipment for your player, please purchase BLACK attire for breezers, helmets, gloves, etc.. \*\***

## **Jersey Orders**

**Game Jerseys Only:** A set includes a home and away jersey with rocker. The cost is \$140.00 adult and youth sizes

**Game Socks:** If you wish to get new game socks. The cost is \$ 30.00 per pair (white and black)

**Practice Jerseys:** A set includes a white and black practice jersey. The cost is \$40.00 per set for adult and youth sizes.

**Full Set:** If you are needing a full set of jerseys. A set includes a home and away jersey with rocker and 2 sets of game socks, and 2 practice jerseys. The cost is \$210 per full set for adult or youth sizes.

# Hockey Cheat Sheet

## Penalties

**Checking from behind:** hitting an opponent who is not aware of behind contact and cannot defend himself

**Cross Checking:** making a check with both hands on the stick

**Elbowing:** using an elbow to foul an opponent

**Fighting:** called fisticuffs in the NHL rule book, assessed when players drop gloves and throw punches at one another

**Hooking:** a player impedes the progress of an opponent by “hooking” them with their stick

**Interference:** a player impedes the progress of an opponent who does not have the puck, deliberately knocks the stick out of an opponent’s hand, preventing player from picking up dropped equipment

**Roughing:** striking another opponent in a minor altercation that the referee determines is not worthy of a major penalty

**Slashing:** a player hits an opponent with their stick to impede progress or cause injury

**Tripping:** a stick or any portion of a player’s body is used to cause an opposing player to fall

## Positions

**Goalie:** The toughest of all positions, the job entails keeping the puck out of the net and most importantly keeping the team’s confidence up

**Defensemen:** Usually two on the ice at a time, one on the left side and one on the right

**Right Wing:** Needs to be a physical player who is good along the boards and in the corner, responsible for the oppositions left defenseman in the defensive zone

**Left Wing:** Needs to be able to dig out the puck from the corners and battle in front of the net, traditionally a left handed shot

**Center:** Good at face-offs and passing, coaches need a lot of hockey smarts and creativity from this position
