Call to Order

Approval of last meeting's minutes

Mark Miller/Jaime Goodwin- TTC

- We asked for clarity in scheduling to make sure that when ice time was reserved for WAHA, there was ample parking and locker rooms included. Last years mishaps in locker rooms and parking was addressed
