



2025-2026 Parent/Player Agreement

Players – Each Athlete:

- Will continually display sportsmanship and be courteous to teammates, opponents, coaches and officials
- Will be encouraged to support other 501 Volley teams whenever possible
- Will wear Nike uniforms and accessories during all tournaments or game situations outside of practice
- Will wear practice shirts to all practices
- Will present and maintain a positive, encouraging attitude toward practice, teammates, and coaches
- Will be open to learning and changing technical skill, i.e., Be Coachable
- Will arrive on time to begin practice at their designated time, normally 15 minutes prior to start time
- Will dress appropriately, with modest attire, clean court shoes and hair pulled back out of their face
- Will help maintain the cleanliness of practice facilities
- Will assist with set-up or take-down of court equipment as needed
- Will adhere to the Coach's direction, not outside influences from parents or bystanders.
- Will be subject to consequences should any negative/inappropriate attitude or actions be demonstrated, to include but not limited to removal from the facility to loss of practice and/or playing time.
- ALL team practices are mandatory
- Any absence requires notification from a player or parent to the coach within 12 hours minimum, except for emergencies

Parents – Each Parent:

- Will encourage and support their child (children) and their child's teammates and coaches
- Will support other 501 Volley teams when feasible
- Will provide volunteer support during 501 Volley hosted tournaments
- Will display, at all times, positive, encouraging attitudes and behavior during practices, tournaments, etc.
- Will ensure financial support for their child is provided (noting that there are non-refundable costs)
- Will be subject to consequences should any negative/inappropriate attitude or actions be demonstrated, to include but not limited to removal from the facility or tournament to loss of membership.
- Parents will not disturb the Coach or the team during practice or tournaments unless requested by the Coach, not a player.
- Any grievances will first be directed by the Parent to the club directors, not the coach.
- Parents shall NOT discuss playtime, team outcomes, etc with the coach during competition. And shall NOT communicate comments or complaints directly to the coach until 24 hours after the event is over.
- Parents should direct concerns or complaints to the 501 Volley administration by emailing info@501volley.com
- 501 Volley administration and coaches will not discuss the playing time with anyone, but that player's parents.

Health and Well Being – Each Athlete:

- Will adhere to USAV policies regarding drug and alcohol abuse
- Will properly hydrate and provide for appropriate hydration during practices and tournaments
- Will attempt to refrain or substantially limit the intake of carbonated soft drinks
- Will eat balanced meals and avoid snack foods and candies during practices and tournaments
- Will try to get at least 8 hours of sleep each night, especially during tournaments
- Will report any and all injuries to the coach
- Will report any symptoms, exposures or quarantines related to Covid-19 to the club directors immediately

Travel:

- Athlete travel costs are NOT included in Player Fees.
- Athletes will travel with their families or other athletes' families. They may NOT drive themselves to tournaments outside of the Central Arkansas area.
- Players are NOT to travel with coaches or 501 Volley administration unless they are direct family members.
- 501 Volley will attempt to provide block rooms at select hotels for the club that parents may utilize

The player hereby acknowledges that volleyball or any sporting event is an extreme test of a person’s physical and mental limits and that the player’s participation in or travel to a volleyball event may result in property damage, serious injury, or death. With a full understanding of the potential risks, the player hereby knowingly and freely assumes all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the released parties, and assumes full and sole responsibility for the player’s participation in and travel to such activities. The player, on the player’s behalf and on behalf of the player’s personal representatives, heirs, family members, successors, and assigns hereby: a) waives, releases and discharges the release of parties from any and all claims or liabilities for personal injury, death, or damages of any kin which arise out of or relate to the player’s traveling to and from or participation in any volleyball or other event involving 501 Volley, and b) agree to not sue any of the release parties for any claims or liabilities arising out of or related to the player’s travel to or participation in volleyball or other activities involving 501 Volley, c) indemnifies and holds harmless the released parties from any claims made or liabilities incurred as a result of the player’s or the player’s family member’s actions.
