 - o 2025-26 Concession Stand Plan
 - Canton Rec Committee received multiple proposals
 - Offer made to The Blue House earlier today, but no contract signed yet
 - CMH will notify parents we do not need to do concessions, once this offer is confirmed & signed
 - CMH has been asked to empty all items (food & supplies) from the concessions stand. This includes the point of sale software & i-Pad.
 - Village wants to purchase all equipment, except the chest freezer (old & rusty). Need to determine value of all equipment based on purchase date & current condition

V. Financial Update

- Each team is responsible for adding ice time & ref costs to an expense report spreadsheet so invoices can be easily tracked & reconciled

VI. New Items

- 10U Bears Goalie Equipment Request
 - Team does not have a dedicated goalie (with own equipment), requesting that CMH provide 1 set of goalie gear
 - Ryan asked the coach to provide a “wish list” of goalie gear to purchase
 - Brian to check on current balance of CMH’s donation account, might use funds from there to cover this cost
 - Motion: Proceed with getting a quote for 1 (possibly 2) sets of goalie gear, and then CMH Board to make a final decision on how much to spend once price is known
