<p>December 9, 2024</p>	<p>Vote: To transfer funds to gambling bank account.</p> <p>Denise Thornburgh made a motion that the Apple Valley Quarterback Club transfer \$15k of cash on hand to the Gambling account for the purposes of seeding the gambling fund."</p> <p>Current cash on hand is \$34,785 + CD of \$20,000. We have checks/bills outstanding of \$8,949. So essentially \$25,836 available before this transfer and \$10,836 remaining after the transfer. We have roughly \$6,500 coming in yet from the program/golf/vikings, etc. CD frees up early March so we'll be back up near the \$38k before spring.</p> <p>The Gambling "working capital" needs were determined based on feedback from vendor as follows:</p> <p>\$3k for E-tabs and then \$4 per pull tab machine (we'll have two) and then an additional \$1k per gambling activity in the bank (3).
