The meeting was called to order at 8:34 pm and began with the 14u update with the Woodstock Board members, Jeremy and Kevin, in attendance. Brock Barton reported that not much had changed since last month. Brock is going to send communication to families this week that we have enough for three teams and summer opportunities. The board discussed ways that we can support and strengthen the Woodstock partnership as families enter into the Swarm collaboration. Woodstock is going to launch their summer opportunity soon.
