EXECUTIVE ADMINISTRATOR

- Sports Engine Access. Cannot add or remove players to roster that are not approved by Jill. These changes can only be done by Jill. We cannot keep Sports Engine Access open if these changes are going to continue.
- Emergency Goalie Policy. It's not a free pass because he is on your roster, it's in terms for injury or illness.
