General Duties

- Attends monthly general board meetings
- Assists the Executive Director with
 - o Communicating league rules and policy to coaches and parents
 - o Creating team rosters and game schedules
 - o Ensuring each game has an assigned umpire
 - o Updating the CGYBS website with game scores
 - o Assisting with the Opening Day Parade and Picture Day

Director on Duty. During the course of the season, directors are required to sign up for DoD at CGYBS fields on game days. Boys Directors are assigned to Maplewood, Jr. High or ARS. Girls Directors are assigned to Maplewood. General duties to include:

- Ensures CGYBS and D26 rules are followed
- Monitors the weather and all other safety related matters
- Secures CGYBS property to include bases and scoreboard numbers
- DoD will have use of a golf cart to assist in all duties

Director of Concession. This position will oversee food operations at the Maplewood and or Jr High snack shack. You will need to have an Illinois Food Handler Certification and will ensure the snack shack is in compliance with Illinois Department of Public Health standards. You will assist with training and supervision of a small staff and schedule work shifts. The snack shack accounts for a large fraction of CGYBSs incoming budget and contributes to the overall baseball and softball atmosphere at Maplewood.
