NEFYSL: There was questionable behavior by U12 Mountain Top coaches last weekend. It may not be brought to KYSA attention given non-involvement. They are considering if having a NEFYSL representative at games is a viable option. KYSA is still waiting on Fall Invoice from NEFYSL.

Shane Farrell voiced concerns over lack of support from EPYSA and reached out to SAY soccer, based in Ohio. Tom voiced desire to speak with other clubs that have experience with this governing body. NEPSAY (a Lakawana county league) is affiliated with SAY.

Festival: Scheduled for October 23rd and 24th. KYSA is hosting U12 girls and U19 coed; both play on the 9v9 fields this season. County already has one 9v9 field, the 7v7 field can be stretched out, and DJ is looking into viability of a 3rd field.

U12 girls will have 9 teams with 2 divisions. Top 4 teams will play elimination round on Sunday. 1st and 2nd place teams receive a medal. We are looking into T-shirts for older players as a parting gift from KYSA.
