

WEVA Junior Report for February:

Event Committee:

- 1) Re-evaluated Xtreme tournament – moved to a “1” classification
- 2) Will consider moving Baystate up after evaluating teams that register to participate – request by Xtreme to re-evaluate
- 3) Sent e-mail note to club directors on the BID Qualifier – date, deadline, informing them that registration to Nationals will have to be completed prior to the event
- 4) Inquiries on the WEVA festival – 5/10 – registrations were requested to be sent to John at the region office
- 5) WEVA rankings of teams will be posted to website (after tournaments results entered in the system) and sent to the National office the first of each month.
- 6) NETS first event was successful – 60 teams at Hocus Pocus across 3 age divisions– all 7 teams from the NETS league participated in the event for the 18's - 5 teams made the GOLD division and the 16's - 6 teams made the GOLD Division – the 14's division was not a NETS event.
