



Tee Ball (5 & under) – Introductory level where coaches help teach baseball fundamentals, knowledge and to make it fun. Positive baseball instruction as the ground level should hopefully set up the child for success in our older divisions.

Rookies (7 & under) – Our Rookies division expands on the basic fundamentals but the division challenges them with a pitching machines as well as playing on a diamond with 60 foot bases. All defensive positions are filled with an additional outfielder (4 total).

Farm (8 & under) – Everything is the same as Rookies, except in this division we introduce kid pitching. The first few weeks of the season, coaches pitch to their own teams, and then we transition to kids pitching to the opposing teams. Stealing is also introduced albeit in a modified form.

Minors (9 under & 10 under) – Depending on the size of this division, it can either be played as combined 9 and 10 year old or, we can split it separate 9u and 10u divisions. Traditional 9 outfielders, steals (no leadoffs yet) and a bit bigger outfield fence. Kid pitching starts to improve here and batter abilities have grown from our lower divisions.

Majors (11under & 12 under) – our most advanced division as our players next step will be middle school baseball or Babe Ruth. 50/70 field with fences 200 feet or more. We introduce leadoffs and balks. The game plays at a much faster pace and pitching abilities have really developed. Likewise, even with the faster pitching and deeper fences, this is the division we see the most Homeruns.

- *Please note, all kids may “play up” in divisions if their skill level warrants it. Safety is always a top concern, so you must get boardmember approval to play up.*
- *Should you have any questions regarding the proper division for you child, please don’t hesitate to ask*
