SHOWDOWN WITH THE SAINTS

LAST GAME - CHICAGO: The Steel prevailed in a 3-2 overtime victory against the Dubuque Fighting Saints on Saturday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena. It was the team's fifth consecutive victory, the second-longest streak of the season. Chicago's power play unit was kept off the scoreboard for just the seventh time this season, going 0-for-2 (0.0%). The Steel penalty kill successfully cancelled out both penalties it faced, charting a 2-for-2 (100%) night. Dubuque won the shots on goal battle by a 25-17 margin through regulation and overtime, holding the Steel to their lowest shot total during the 2020-2021 season. **Ryan Ufko** tallied the game-winner in overtime while **Joe Miller** picked up his second multi-point game (1G, 1A) of the season. **Erik Middendorf** added a marker for the Steel and **Simon Latkoczy** made 23 saves in the win.

LAST GAME - DUBUQUE: The Fighting Saints earned a point in the standings but fell by a 3-2 score in overtime against the Steel on Saturday night at Fox Valley Ice Arena. Dubuque led 2-1 early in the third period but surrendered the final two goals in the loss. Despite holding the second-ranked Chicago power play unit off the board in two chances, the Fighting Saints could not light the lamp with their two opportunities on the man advantage. Dubuque outshot the Steel 25-17, holding Chicago to their lowest shot total of the season. **Max Burkholder** and **Andrei Buyalsky** netted markers in the loss and **Lukas Parik** made 15 stops through regulation and overtime.

AGAINST THE FIGHTING SAINTS: Chicago has not lost to the Fighting Saints in regulation since April 6, 2019. The last time Dubuque defeated the Steel at Fox Valley Ice Arena was Nov. 26, 2016. Dating back to the start of the 2019-2020 regular season, Chicago owns a 6-0-1-0 mark against the Eastern Conference foe.

SMELLS LIKE UFD OG: Over 29 games played this season, UMass-Amherst commit **Ryan Ufko** has registered 29 points (8G, 21A). That total ranks second among USHL defensemen and 10th across all league skaters. The Smithtown, N.Y., native was recently elevated to a 'B'-level prospect by NHL Central Scouting's latest watch list released on Jan. 21, 2021.

COTTON HEADED MIDDY MUGGINS: Steel captain **Erik Middendorf** scored his 22nd marker of the season on Saturday night. The Michigan State University commit ranks second on the league goal scoring list, trailing his teammate, **Matt Coronato**, by one goal.

DUBUQUE DETAILS: Fighting Saints forward **Connor Kurth** leads the team and ranks second among USHL rookies with 22 points (10G, 12A) through 26 games played but was held off the scoresheet in the loss to the Steel on Saturday night. The Elk River, Minn., native has recorded seven points (3G, 4A) over his last nine games.
