PASSING NOTES: During the 2018 season Waunakee's Jarrett Wulf completed a then record (150 passing attempts or more) 74.7 % of his passes In three mid-season wins Wulf completed 8 of 8 passes for 192 yards and 2 touchdowns vs. Portage followed by 9 of 9 passe completions for 172 yards and 4 touchdowns vs. Sauk Prairie and then his record tying 14 for 14 passing vs. Reedsburg for 295 yards and 3 touchdowns. During the 2020 Fall season Maddox Allen of Cumberland passed up Wulf with a remarkable 80.5% Allen completed 149 passes in 185 attempts. Against Chetek-Weyerhaeuser he was 11 of 11 for 129 yards and 3 touchdowns. In 2021 he was 16 of 16 passing for 307 ysrds and 2 scores vs. again, Chetek-Weyerhaeuser. Allen is the only player on the above list to have completed at least 10 of 10 passes in a game twice.
