## **Ellsworth High School Boosters Club Meeting April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at Clyde's Corner**

1. Called meeting to order at 6 pm. Meeting was rescheduled from March 26, 2024, to April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
2. Attendance: Lisa Acker, Melissa Gutting, Mike Gutting, Patricia Peterson, Casey Peterson, Holly Johnson, and Tom Diercks.
3. Approved the February 25, 2024, meeting minutes. Motion by Mike, Second by Patricia.
4. Approved Treasurer's Report. Balance at the end of March was \$14,180.49. Reimbursement to Mike Gutting for sound system hook up items for \$272.08 was approved. Motion made by Casey, Second by Holly.
5. Old Business updates:
  - a. Melissa placed banner order with Helmer printing for the six seniors. Photos taken by Lisa and proofs approved by seniors.
  - b. Visor order placed with Designs by Jill. This was approved via text string vote of the board for \$16.00 each. Ordered for this year's players and six extra for 2025 players.
  - c. Game Day Shirts were ordered from Designs by Jill. The seniors designed them, and Jill tweaked a little for color purposes. Shirts were \$16.25 each.
  - d. Snapraise fundraiser went live March 22, 2024.
  - e. A new date for the team banquet was set for June 19, 2024, from 5-7 at the Ridgetop. Cost of \$14.00 per person. Boosters cover player cost.
  - f. Parents night will be 4/22 and will do the flowers from Sargent's and cheese curds from the creamery. Will contact Brad Beissel on Cheese Curds.
  - g. Youth Alumni Night will be 4/12. Seniors like the poster idea. Mariah is arranging bat girls for the home games. Approval to order posters from Helmer was done via an e-mail sting as they needed to be ordered before the 4/7/24 meeting to arrive on time. Cost was \$105.00
  - h. Senior night gifts discussed. Boosters will allot \$240.00 (or \$40 per player) for the Juniors to purchase gifts for Senior night. Melissa Gutting working on gift for seniors for senior night. Boosters allotted \$100 per player for senior gifts between the two nights.
  - i. Verizon equipment is activated for the season (tablets and hotspots for cameras).
  - j. An email vote was taken prior to the meeting to allow Tom to purchase four team bats for use by the JV and Varsity teams. Total was not to exceed \$1200. A reimbursement was made to Tom for the purchase.
6. New Business:
  - a. Discussed funding request from the High School Athletic Director. The school is looking for teams to contribute to the cost of summer training or an athletic training for the school year. Booster would like more information on what other booster clubs are contributing and how other schools pay for this. Also, what is the actual cost and what is the school going to cover.
  - b. Discussed food for away tournaments such as coolers for water, subs for girls, etc. Boosters approved \$250.00 for beverages during the season to have these items available during home and away games.
7. Next Meeting date was not set and was going to be discussed at a game.
8. Meeting adjourned at 7:15.

Hey Everyone-

I sent out the automated thank yous to donors and the participants through SnapRaise. Based on their official total, we raised \$10,346.00. However, we also had \$445 turned in separately (cash/checks from Aliza, Madi, Mya and Aubrey) that was added in, making it \$10,791.

Snapraise has sent us the following deposits, which is 80% of \$10,346. They keep 20 percent of those funds. We keep 100% of the cash funds as we didn't report them to SnapRaise. So the total amount that went into the bank should be \$8,721.80 with this fundraiser. Our top earners were Aliza (\$1295), Mya (1055) and Delaney (1035) but Madi was right in there with \$1010.00. So, I will have Patrica get the three gift cards to get to them at the awards night or before. I attached the spreadsheet showing who raised what amount. There was a \$35.00 donation via Snapraise that was not associated with any player so that isn't showing on the spreadsheet but it is reflected in the total of \$10,346 (the spreadsheet shows \$10,311 plus the cash donations).

Thanks and that wraps up our fundraising efforts for this season. We will look into the other option Drew shared with us for next year as they don't take a "cut" apparently.

Hey guys-

I just wanted to share this with you as Drew generously shared it with the EHS SB Boosters. We had previously utilized SnapRaise for online fundraising but they keep 20% of all the funds raised to cover their costs. This option is 100% identical to SnapRaise (without losing a large chunk of donations) from what I could see today and they give you 100% of the funds raised. They make their money through "tips" that donors offer up when they check out of the site. This could be anything from \$1.00 to whatever they want to give to offset the costs. They can also opt not to leave a "tip" and no one comes after you for costs incurred. The only money they do keep is the credit card transaction fees of roughly 3% plus .30 per transaction. So you don't get the whole \$25.00 (or whatever they donate) but you do get roughly \$24.00 versus SnapRaise taking \$6.25 and charging the credit card fee to the donor as well. So if I donate \$25.00, the team would only get \$18.75 and I get charged a transaction fee of close to \$2.00 I believe.

They do not have a large marketing budget due to this so if you are interested in hearing more or this might be an option you want to consider to raise funds for either association, please reach out to Sara Dyke, directly. Her contact info is listed below.

The Softball Boosters will be utilizing them for our fundraising next spring. Track used them this year.
