

- 5th and 6th grade will start the game with a normal jump ball.
- **3pointers ARE ALLOWED.**
- *Clock-* There will be **two 16 minute halves** with a **continuous clock**. The clock will **only stop for timeouts, injuries and last minute of each half**. There will be one 2-minute overtime with the clock stopping the final minute. After **one overtime**, if the game is still tied, there will be a 1-minute overtime. After the second OT, we will play sudden death, first to score. Team will receive **3 timeouts per game. Only 2 timeouts will carry over to 2nd half if you don't use one in the first half**. One additional timeout will be given in overtime. The score and clock keepers are all volunteers so please be understanding of any oversights or mistakes.
 - Each team needs to supply 1 person to help run the clock/score sheet.
- If we get ahead, we will stay ahead to please be ready to roll!
- A game ball will be provided. All teams must provide their own warm up balls.
- *Fouls - Each* player will be allowed no more than five personal fouls. Any player receiving more than one technical foul will be disqualified from game. **Free throws will be shot for all shooting fouls. Ball is live on the release!**
 - Minimum of four (4) players are required to be on the floor for the game to start or continue.

Defense- 5/6 Grade:

- Only man to man defense is allowed. One warning will be given for zone defense. It will be a technical foul if called for a second time.
- **No Full Court Defense**
 - The defense is allowed to pick up at half court.
- **Subs-All need to check in at the score table.**
- *Sportsmanship-* **All coaches and players shall practice good sportsmanship. If a coach receives a technical foul, they will not be allowed to stand up the remainder of that game (timeouts are an exception). If the coach receives a 2nd technical foul at any time during the day, they will be asked to leave the facility for the day. We are here for the kids to play the game and enjoy themselves. They feed off the energy of their coach and fans so please be positive towards the players, officials and other teams. This will help make this run smoothly and make it an enjoyable day of basketball for everyone!**
- There will be zero tolerance for fans berating officials. If the ref deems their actions inappropriate at any point, then they may be asked to leave the facility for the day. No warning is necessary. Coaches may be asked to talk to anyone causing a problem first.
