- If it appears a player bats out of order it is NOT the scorekeepers job to notify the umpire. The scorekeeper remains quiet.

- Keep track of pitchers and outs recorded by each recorded pitcher
- **NEW! Changes to scorecards this year - keeping track of catchers**
- 2020 Spring Rules and Regulations, Section 1 paragraph 4->
 - All pitching and catching changes are submitted to the umpire and official scorekeeper, before the change takes place. In the event a pitching change occurs in the middle of an at bat, and the batter records an out the out shall be charged to both pitchers. In the event of an unreported pitching change, outs will be charged to both pitchers (the pitcher of record and the pitcher currently pitching) until the change is officially made with the umpire.
