

COVID Reporting Procedures

If a team participant including but not limited to players, coaches, managers, etc. tests positive, the entire team must quarantine.

The team must advise the other members of the team, the Travel Commissioner, and Executive Director. The manager must submit the name of the COVID-19 positive person and a list of the team members with whom the COVID-19 positive person came in contact.

With the exception of the Department of Public Health, the name of the COVID-19 positive person must remain confidential.

Anyone who has come in contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19 must quarantine for ten (10) days and advise their team members, Travel Commissioner, and Executive Director. If that person shows any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, he/she must immediately contact their healthcare provider and advise the league.

Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 must quarantine for at least ten (10) days and not show any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, have no fever for at least 72 hours without fever-reducing medication or have 2 negative COVID-19 tests in a row with testing being done at least 24 hours apart and submit to their manager prior to returning to activity a signed written clearance from a medical doctor showing that the person has been cleared to participate.
