Tiny Tiger Hockey Registration is Open:

This level is designed for first year players 4-7 years old who are just learning to skate and play hockey. However, players' abilities vary greatly, and it is not unusual to have players of these ages at other Mite levels. At the Tiny Tigers level, hockey is purely instructional. Development of skills and having fun are the main goals. Practice times are one day per weekend and there are no scheduled games or travel. Tiny Tigers run December 9th thru February 29th on Saturday mornings. Registration Fee is \$50 per skater and will have up to 12 sessions. PYHA has a limited amount of equipment that will be loaned out to Tiny Tiger skaters on a first come, first serve basis. This will require a \$200 deposit and will be returned at end of season when equipment is handed in. Please keep checking PYHA calendar for these equipment hand out dates.
