

## DLL Covid-19 Acknowledgement

The highest priority of Downtown Little League (DLL) is the safety of its players, families, staff, and visitors.

I know that by engaging in baseball activities at DLL facilities, my child may be exposed to COVID-19 and other infections. I also understand that despite all reasonable efforts by DLL and its staff, my child can still contract COVID-19 and other infections. In order to reduce my child's risk, I agree to be an active participant in maintaining my child's health, wellbeing and safety, as well as the safety of others, by following all the guidelines and expectations outlined by DLL and local and state health authorities.

As more information is gathered and known, I understand that DLL may modify these guidelines and expectations. It is my responsibility to make every effort to keep myself apprised of these changes to protect my child and the DLL community.

I agree to protect my child and the DLL community by doing the following:

- Wear a face mask when interacting with DLL staff during games.
- Ensure that my child brings at least one cloth face mask when required.
- Monitor my child for the following symptoms:
  - A fever of 100°F or higher
  - Respiratory symptoms, such as dry cough, shortness of breath, or a sore throat
  - Headache or body aches
  - Chills
  - Loss of taste or smell
- Keep my child at home if they exhibit any of these symptoms or are otherwise feeling sick.
- Promptly arrange for my child to be picked up when notified by DLL staff if my child shows signs of illness.
- In the event my child has a fever, keep my child home until they have been fever free without fever-reducing medication for at least 24 hours.
- Timely report to Joel Steiger (415-608-5739 or Joel.steiger@gmail.com) if your child tests positive for COVID-19.

DLL staff will isolate from the group any player who develops symptoms of illness and notify their emergency contact to pick them up. DLL is required to notify local health authorities if a child or employee test positive for COVID-19. DLL will work with local health departments to identify potentially infected or exposed individuals to help facilitate effective contact tracing and notifications. I acknowledge and agree that my child will be asked to do the following during the tournament:

- Follow instructions to practice physical distancing.
- Wear a cloth face mask when asked by DLL staff.
- Frequently wash and/or sanitize their hands.
- Keep their personal belongings separate from those of other players, and not share personal items.

I have discussed these expectations with my child, and they also understand and agree to follow them.

I understand COVID-19 is a highly contagious virus and it is possible for my child to develop and contract the COVID-19 disease, even if I and my child follow all of the safety precautions above. I understand that although DLL is following the coronavirus guidelines issued by the State of New York, my child can never be completely shielded from all risk of illness caused by COVID-19 or other infections.

I have read, understand, and agree to comply with the expectations above. I also acknowledge that these expectations are a condition of my child's participation in DLL baseball and tournament programs and that failure to comply with them may lead to termination from the programs.
