Re: Policies & Procedures – Phase 4 Update (Effective October 5, 2020)

The Mount Prospect Ice Arena will continue to follow Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan and its All Sports Policy. In this Phase, high-risk sports can currently play at Level 1: no-contact practices and trainings only; 5v5 flow drills will be permitted. Our policies and procedures are based upon current guidelines set forth by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), as well as state and local government agencies. These policies and procedures are requirements, not recommendations. Your adherence to these policies and procedures is **REQUIRED**. Any violation of the below policies and procedures may result in your excusal from the building.

1. Anyone showing symptoms or signs of sickness, or who have been in contact with known positive cases, **PLEASE STAY HOME**.
 - a. Participants with symptoms or signs of illness are strictly advised **not** to enter the premises and to seek medical assistance.
 - i. Coaches shall dismiss players exhibiting signs or symptoms of illness.
 - b. Participants with risk factors or illnesses should **not** attend on-ice sessions.
2. **All** skaters, including coaches and supervisors, must sign a hold harmless waiver before entering the facility.
 - a. Parents and/or guardians must sign the hold harmless waiver if the participant is under 18 years of age.
 - b. Visit <https://boltshockey.sportngin.com/register/form/919865615> to complete an online waiver, making for a contact free process.
3. Skaters, coaches, and supervisors **must** wear face coverings over their noses & mouths at all times except for while on the ice, when eating, drinking or when outside and able to maintain a safe social distance.

4. Spectators are allowed inside the building for **all** on-ice activities.
 - a. Limit **one** spectator per participant.
 - b. Spectators are limited to immediate household members or guardians of participants.
 - c. Spectators **must** wear face coverings over their noses & mouths at all times except for when eating, drinking or when outside and able to maintain a safe social distance.
 - d. Spectator seating is limited to the bleachers in the North & South Rinks and Billy Bricks Wood Fired Pizza for **paying customers only**.
 - e. LiveBarn will be turned back off.
5. Group sizes of 50 people or fewer (includes skaters, coaches & supervisors; excludes spectators) are allowed in each rink with this limit subject to change based on latest data and guidance.
6. The following onsite areas will **remain** closed to the public:
 - a. Main Office & Conference Room
 - b. Main Concourse – TVs, tables, chairs, benches, gaming consoles, and bubble hockey machine.
 - i. Spectators may pass through the Main Concourse **only** to access the public restrooms, vending machines, and Jerry’s Hockey.
 1. Loitering in the Main Concourse will **not** be tolerated.
 2. The touchless water bottle refill station is to be used for **bottle refills only**.
 - a. Drinking from it directly is prohibited.
7. The Off-Ice Training Facility & Party Room are available upon request, per the discretion of Mount Prospect Ice Arena Management.
8. Team locker rooms are available for use **15 minutes** prior to scheduled ice times.
 - a. Coaches & skaters **must** wear face coverings over their noses and mouths when inside the team locker rooms.
 - b. Coaches & skaters are encouraged to wash their hands with soap and water before/after participating.

- c. Coaches & skaters shall follow social distancing guidelines while inside the team locker rooms.
 - d. Skaters are encouraged to arrive as fully dressed as possible to minimize the amount of time spent inside the team locker rooms.
 - e. Bathrooms are available for use.
 - f. Showers are **not** available for use to ensure that staff has enough time in-between users to perform the necessary cleaning procedures.
 - g. Private Locker Room users are **not** allowed to leave their equipment after use.
9. Team benches are available for use.
- a. Coaches and skaters shall follow social distancing guidelines while on the team benches.
10. Touchless water bottle refill stations are available for use in the North & South Rinks for ***bottle refills only***.
- a. Drinking from them directly is prohibited.
 - b. Skaters are ***still*** required to bring in and label their own water bottles; no sharing of water.
11. Please refer to the **site logistics plan** for instructions relevant to your visit to the Mount Prospect Ice Arena during Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan.

The knowledge and circumstances surrounding COVID-19 are constantly changing and, as such, the Mount Prospect Ice Arena makes no representation and assumes no responsibility for the accuracy or completeness of these policies and procedures. We believe that the above policies and procedures will continue to ***help*** allow for the safe use of our facility. NORTH RINK

SKATERS, COACHES & SUPERVISORS...

...will enter through the main entrance doors 15 minutes before their scheduled ice time begins, walk through the concourse and into the North Rink where they will proceed underneath the grandstands and into their assigned locker room(s). Following their on-ice session, players will return to their assigned locker room(s), get undressed, and exit the North Rink through the doors nearest to Jerry's Hockey within 15 minutes after their scheduled ice time ends.

SPECTATORS...

...will enter through the main entrance doors at the scheduled start time, walk through the concourse and into the North Rink where they will proceed into the grandstands. Following the event, spectators will clear the grandstands and exit the North Rink through the doors nearest to Jerry's Hockey within 10 minutes after the event ends.

SOUTH RINK

SKATERS, COACHES & SUPERVISORS...

...will enter through the main entrance doors 15 minutes before their scheduled ice time begins, walk through the concourse and into the South Rink where they will proceed underneath the grandstands and into their assigned locker room(s). Following their on-ice session, players will return to their assigned locker room(s), get undressed, and exit the South Rink through the doors nearest to the Notre Dame College Prep Locker Room within 15 minutes after their scheduled ice time ends.

SPECTATORS...

...will enter through the main entrance doors at the scheduled start time, walk through the concourse and into the South Rink where they will proceed into the grandstands. Following the event, spectators will clear the grandstands and exit the South Rink through the doors nearest to the Notre Dame College Prep Locker Room within 10 minutes after the event ends.
