Message from Admin:

Kate Obrien – Thank you to HBC for continued support. We really miss your kids and wish all families wellness and are looking forward to more connections.

Updates: HHS opened @ 1800 students, less students have moved to running start so class sizes are bigger >>>we are working to level this out. All 3 high schools have large 9th grade classes. Teachers are getting better and better at delivering content and are finding new and different ways, hoping for additional growth and connections.

Feedback is critical for growth in this new format.

Superintendents using metrics of return based on decision tree from King County following Public Health guidelines. These are different for each level. Virus rate will need to be 25 per 100,000 for high schools to open classrooms. Before the start of school number was 89, now at 55. Hoping to continue with downward trend and possibly come back this year. Governors phases are also linked to counties.
