



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Players are expected to adhere and support to the following guidelines. Failure to do so may result from removal from Chaska Baseball Association after a full review by the current executive board members.

1. Players are expected to maintain positive support and encouragement of all other players while participating in Chaska Baseball Association Program.
2. Players are to exhibit good sportsmanship by demonstrating respect and positive support of all other players, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports activity.
3. Players will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of all other players ahead of any personal desire to win.
4. Players will be responsible to do their best to ensure that all play is in a safe and healthy environment.
5. Players will support coaches and officials working with all other players to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
6. Players will support a drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free environment by refraining from their use at all youth sports events.
7. Players will remember that youth sports activities are for the physical exercise and enjoyment.
8. Players will do their best to make youth sports fun for all players.
9. Players will treat other players, coaches, officials, and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
10. Players are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after all games.
11. Players will be responsible for team issued uniforms and equipment. Failure to return any required uniform or equipment to the head coach will be the financial responsibility of his/her parents.
