

USA/CHRVA Background Screening

Any adult who is USAV registered and who plans to participate as a member of a CHRVA Junior's team is required to submit to the background screening process for USAV. This includes at minimum: coaches, club directors, team reps, chaperones, and any other individual, over the age of 18, who in his/her normal team/club duties, could potentially have custodial care of a CHRVA registered minor, not including his/her child. This also includes those who have privileges to personal information of these minors. A typical example is a club administrator who has Member Management viewing privileges for the members of a club.

Important Things To Remember

Request your background check as soon as you know you will make the commitment to a junior team. It is important that you do this early to avoid being in line to be screened behind all the other applicant's around the country. Remember that it takes several days for the process to complete and in the meantime, you are not allowed to participate in sanctioned events, including practice.

When you register as an adult member, you have the option of requesting a background check. Within 3 - 7 business days, the results will be communicated back to you, the Region, and your member record.
