Rugby Oregon Rules Variations Updated 2/10/2020

Rugby Oregon exceptions to IRB Law for boys:

1. Time (**5.1**): Instead of two 10-minute halves, Rugby Oregon will play two 20-minute halves (total game time of 40 minutes), with a 10-minute half time
2. Scoring, conversions (**8.7**): Instead of all conversions being drop kick, Rugby Oregon will allow a place kick or drop kick. The time allowed for the conversion is 60 seconds from the time the try is awarded (**8.7d**)

Rugby Oregon exceptions to IRB Law for girls:

- 1) Time (5.1): A match lasts a total of 40 minutes, divide into four 10-minutes quarters. Each quarter is separated by a 5-minutes break in play
- 2) 2. Half-time (5.2): Instead of a 2-minute half-time, Rugby Oregon will allow a 5 minute half-time.
- 3) Scoring, conversions (8.7): Instead of all conversions being drop kick, Rugby Oregon will allow a place kick or drop kick. The time allowed from the conversion is 60 seconds from the time the try is awarded (8.7d)

Note for both boys and girls games:

Restarts do not deviate from 10s law (**12.7**): After a team has scored, the same team restarts with a drop kick on or behind the center of the half-way line. The restart kick must be taken within 30 seconds. Not 10 on a restart is a free kick.
