

Red Bank Armory Ice Complex

Guidelines

October 15, 2020

- If a player or immediate family member has any symptoms of illness, flu or fever, they should not enter the facility.
- Everyone (over the age of 2) entering the building **MUST WEAR A MASK**. Masks must be worn when entering/exiting the building, and only taken off prior to stepping onto the ice.
- The [Red Bank Armory Waiver](#) must be signed by all skaters prior to entering the facility.
- The [Red Bank Armory Daily Health Screening](#) must be completed by all players/participants, coaches, referees and individuals prior to entering the facility, each day there is a practice/competition/event.
- No spectators allowed in the facility for practices and games.
- The Armory requires players to come fully dressed except for skates, helmets and gloves which can be put on by the benches next to the rink.
- Skaters can only enter the building 15 minutes before their scheduled ice time.
- Skaters must leave promptly (within 10 minutes) after their scheduled ice time.
- All locker rooms will be closed until further notice.
- No food may be brought into the facility.
- No shared water bottles – please bring your own water bottle labeled with your name.
- All coaches are required to sign waivers and wear helmets while on the ice.
- Our staff has increased regular and thorough cleaning of all public areas and disinfecting protocol.
- Hand Sanitizer is available.

DUE TO RECENT STATE OF NEW JERSEY ANNOUNCEMENTS, ANYONE THAT HAS VISITED "HOT SPOT" STATES WITHIN THE LAST 14 DAYS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE FACILITY.
