I pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while participating in a Cary Basketball Association (CBA) event and shall behave in accordance with the following code of conduct:

- I will provide positive support and encouragement for any and all athletes participating in games or practices
- I will not and will not encourage any athlete to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, scorekeeper, or any other attendee
- I will not and will not encourage any athlete to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official, scorekeeper, or any other attendee
- I will not permit my child to use drugs, tobacco, or alcohol while at any CBA event and will not, nor will I let my child attend, coach, officiate, scorekeeper, or participate in a CBA event while under the influence of drugs, tobacco, or alcohol
- I will not personally engage or encourage any player to engage in the use of profanity, or engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official, scorekeeper, or any other attendee at any time before, during or after a CBA game.

NEW ZERO TOLERANCE DISCIPLINARY ACTION - If I or any of my relatives fail to conform to the CBA Code of Conduct while attending or participating in a youth sports event, I or my relatives will be subject to the following disciplinary action:

Suspension from attending any CBA event for the remainder of the season or multiple season suspension AND possible suspension for your child/children as a result of your actions. Disciplinary action will be issued by the CBA Executive Board.
