



## **BATTING CAGE RULES:**

- Water only. NO FOOD OR DRNKS!
- All players inside cage must wear batting helmet. This includes players pitching to each other.
- No trash may be left inside cages.
- Coaches are encouraged to pitch from behind screen for older players or when using hard balls.

## **USAGE RULES:**

- Open 9am- dusk
- All DGS players, families and teams encouraged to use cages.
- All individuals using them will yield to team practices.
- All DGS teams will yield to DHS teams.
- All DGS teams may use batting cages and no division has priority over another
- There are 2 cages, both can be divided in half by nets. Allowing 4 batters or 4 teams at once. Please share with other teams. Don't be a cage hog!
- Teams are encouraged to schedule batting cage practices during DGS games at Great Oak
- Batting Cages are reserved only as follows:
  - Cage 1- closest to Rollins Field, Cage 2- Closest to Upper Field/Tiggies/Snack Bar
  - DGS Teams playing on Rollins Field will have full access to Cage 1 for 1 hour prior to start of game.
  - DGS Teams playing on Tiggies Field will have full access to Cage 2 for 1 hour prior to game.
  - Home Teams have the cage 1<sup>st</sup> 30 minutes; Away Team has cage 2<sup>nd</sup> 30 minutes. Example: Dukes (home) vs Huskies (away) at 6pm on Rollins Field-  
Huskies use Cage 2 for batting warmups from 5-5:30pm. Dukes use Cage 2 for batting warmups from 5:30- 6pm.

- All other teams may use cage before 5pm and after 6pm
- Apply same rules to Saturday games

Coaches are encouraged to check game schedule prior to scheduling practice.
