

Where do we find the practice and game schedules?

- The first two weeks of practice schedules can be found on the OASD website under Athletics/Athletic Schedules or on the Oconomowoc Gridiron website under the calendar tab. The remaining practice schedule will be housed in Hudl.
- Game schedules are also found on the OASD or Gridiron website. However, it's highly suggested that you download the Activity Scheduler app to get up-to-date information regarding game times, game locations with maps and directions and bus departure times.

What is Hudl and is it important?

- Hudl is the main resource for the football program. All players will have access and this is where the practice schedule (among other important information) will be located. It's advised that you create a communication process with your child and family that works best for you.

Should we send food with our son to eat prior to the games?

- The Gridiron Club generously donates meals for every player for every away game. Freshman meals typically have a meat & cheese sandwich, chips or crunchy snack, protein bar, cheese or beef stick, cookie and beverage. The freshman get one meal & beverage as they board the bus after the game.

I'm getting emails about volunteering for concessions from the OSBC. What's this about and do I need to volunteer?

- Yes, please sign up for these requested volunteer dates! The sign up genius will show ALL concession volunteer slots by sport. Look for dates and times that have been labeled "FOOTBALL" which are events other than football that need volunteers to run concessions. Those are the dates/events that we need to fill with volunteers.
