General Conduct

CGAA believes that sportsmanship is an expectation so please let the players play, let the coaches coach, let the officials officiate, and let the spectators be positive. It is important for all players, coaches, and spectators to accept victory with grace and defeat with dignity.

Parent/Guardian Conduct

Parents, guardians, and all spectators are here to support the players, coaches, and officials. Please remember: this is a game meant to be a fun and positive learning experience for children.

- Profanity, degrading language, or negative comments are not allowed
- Respect the judgment of coaches and officials. Encourage all players, coaches, and teams in the spirit of good sportsmanship
- The use of, or being under the influence of, alcohol, tobacco, or drugs at any CGAA facility is strictly prohibited
- Celebrate victory with grace and accept defeat with dignity

Support your player's enjoyment of the game by showing respect for opponents, officials, coaches, and players. Maintain self-control, avoid disrespectful behavior, and remain in designated spectator areas unless invited by a coach or official.
