

Referee Registration Process

If you are interested in becoming a referee, please log onto <http://www.usahockey.com/> and get registered. Everyone signing up is required to attend a seminar for the level that you are applying for, TRF Level 1&2 seminar is 10/8/2018, we will also be hosting a Level 3 seminar 10/13/2018, otherwise you will have to look for another date and location that work best for you. You will need to register for the seminar after you have registered as an official.

Here is a small Checklist for you when getting certified as a ref.

1. Register as a Referee on <http://www.usahockey.com/>
2. Register for your On-Ice Seminar online.
3. Complete On-line Open Book Exam.
4. Complete All On-Line Seminars.
5. Attend On-Ice Seminar and complete Closed book test.
6. Receive and attach crest to your ref jersey(This must happen prior to stepping on the ice to officiate a game.)
7. Contact me with the following information to let me know you have received your crest and that I can start scheduling you for games.
 - Name
 - Address
 - Email(s)
 - Cell Phone Number(s)
 - Hockey Team Playing on/Coaching/etc. (If Applicable)
 - Certification Level Completed.

Please keep in mind as a referee you are required to have the following equipment:

- Referee Jersey w/ valid crest
- Referee pants or Black pants w/o any markings
- 2 Whistles
- Helmet with ½ Shield.
