

## **Photography and Video Recording Policy**

“Organization” refers to: Shorewood Soccer League

This policy is separate from the Picture Waiver presented during registration of players.

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this policy is to outline the guidelines for photography and video recording during soccer games organized by the Organization.

### **Scope:**

This policy applies to all players, coaches, officials, spectators, and any other individuals involved in soccer games organized by the Organization.

### **Policy:**

#### 1. Photography:

- Photography is permitted for personal use by spectators, coaches, and team staff
- Photos may be used for personal purposes only

#### 2. Video Recording:

- Video Recording is permitted for personal use by spectators, coaches, and team staff
- Video Recordings may be used for personal purposes only

#### 3. Privacy:

- Photographs and video recordings should not be used in a manner that infringes on the privacy rights of individuals

#### 4. Distribution and Sharing:

- Photographs and video recordings shall not be distributed or shared publicly without the consent of ALL the individuals recorded
- Casual photos and short video clips taken by families of players are permitted to be shared between family members
- Video recordings may be shared privately between players and team staff
- The Organization reserves the right to request the removal of any video content that is deemed inappropriate or harmful

#### 5. Referee Authority:

- All decisions made by the referee during a match are final and binding
- Video recordings cannot be used to challenge or dispute any calls made by the referee
- The use video evidence to contest a referee's decision will not be entertained

#### 6. Compliance:

- All individuals are expected to comply with this policy
- Non-compliance may result in disciplinary action as determined by the Organization
