

Scarborough Stingers Release Policy

It is the desire and directive of the Scarborough Stingers Baseball Club to field competitive teams in Baseball Ontario's Representative (REP) divisions. The SBA encourages Scarborough residents to play for the Scarborough Stingers.

The SBA is not required or mandated to release a player.

The following procedures will be adhered to regarding player releases:

- 1) No releases shall be granted between May 1 and Labour Day.
- 2) Releases must be signed and issued by the President; coaches or managers have no authority to issue or offer releases.
- 3) Players wishing to tryout for another Toronto Baseball Association team may do so without a release.
- 4) Players wishing to tryout for teams outside the TBA (e.g. YSBA or EOBA), must first be granted a release both by the association (SBA) and the affiliate (TBA). No releases will be issued for teams outside the TBA until after Scarborough Stingers tryouts have occurred.
- 5) Release requests must clearly outline the reason for the release.
- 6) Release requests for players who have been offered a spot on a Scarborough Stingers team may be denied.
- 7) No refunds, if applicable, will be issued to any player who requests a release after October 1.
