1) Call to order

- Board Secretary Brian Anderson called the meeting to order.

2) Prior Meeting Minutes

3) Treasurer's Report

- Brian Anderson reviewed the financials with members in attendance.
- Mike Davis met with M&T Bank on yield earned on current bank accounts. Chuck Marino and Mike Davis will need to go with Kevin Wiese to add as a check signer for the Club.

4) Report of Committees

● House League:

- No updates

● Travel Soccer:

- Mike Davis updated that the travel club has seen lower Red/Yellow cards this season so far.
- Tryouts to be held weekend before and after LDSC Tournament. Individual coaches may schedule their own dates.

● Tournament Committee:

- Struggling on volunteer signups, even with incentives
- Tony Manetta created a parking lot map to maximize parking spaces.
- Idea for local fire company to establish the lot and direct traffic – opportunity for them to do a fundraiser. LDSC Club could also provide a donation to the fire company.
- 75 teams registered – need to fill in some age groups.

5) Old Business

- Westwood Field Project: Balducci land is no longer an affordable option, as the price increased to close to \$1MM. Need a follow-up with the town on existing town land for expansion of Westwood Park to include 6 fields.
- New House Uniforms – Corner Kits is ready to go whenever the Club decides to switch the House program to new uniforms. The current inventory should last through 2024, and new uniforms could be used for Spring 2025

6) New Business

- Walden Pond Turf Project – many different teams involved in discussions, need to understand how field time would be divided between the different sport organizations.
- All-Star game for House league is coming back!
- Scholarships: 6 scholarships given out. 10 applicants in total.
