



#### **GUIDELINES:**

- All participants must wear a mask/face covering at all times off-ice in the facility. Complimentary disposable masks are available if needed.
- Players who are currently sick, recently sick, symptomatic or high-risk/vulnerable to illness should not come to the rink.
- Maximum 50 players on the ice. (to include players, managers & coaches total.)
- Social distancing encouraged at all times in the building, including on the bench, locker room(s) and ice.
- Use of showers in locker rooms is permitted. Social distancing and masks required. Limit time in locker room.
- Do not bring valuables into the building. The Ice Dens are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Bring own FILLED water bottle - no sharing. Water fountains currently disabled.
- Players are encouraged to bring own tissues and personal sanitized wipes/sanitizer.
- NO SPITTING on ice or benches. (Violation will result in loss of ice privileges. No warnings.)
- Follow all posted signs and guidelines.
- Limit time spent in the facility that is outside of scheduled ice slot. Arrive no sooner than 30 minutes prior to your scheduled session and leave promptly at its conclusion.
- Enter the rink through the properly designated doors at main building entrance.

#### **SPECTATORS:**

- Spectators are allowed with the limitation of two (2) spectator per player. No exceptions.
- Social distance yourself from others including staff, players and parents in designated areas only. DO NOT congregate.
- Limit time spent in the facility that is outside of scheduled ice slot.
- Spectators can watch programming Live or On Demand using the Live Barn App. Ice Den 10% Discount Codes: IDS = dd68-4c38 IDC = 1680-0da3
- During normal hours of operation 18 Degrees/18 Degrees Express will air Live Barn as an option for parents/guardians to remain on site or view programming on the East Rink/Coyotes Rink.
- Follow all posted signs and guidelines and adhere to staff requests.

#### **Mitigating Exposure Risk:**

As the Ice Dens transition from spring/summer to fall/winter programming while public health concerns remain policies and procedures will be evaluated and updated as needed to mitigate the spread of illness and provide a safe environment for our community. It is imperative that all participants understand and adhere to program specific rules and requirements as outlined by program directors and staff.
