

**SUNOVA (WARREN) ARENA
WARREN, MANITOBA**

ARENA PROTOCOLS

GENERAL

- Although not mandatory it is recommended that all guests who are not participating wear a mask while in the arena.
- Spectators are expected to maintain social distancing, 2 metres, at all times when in the arena.
- As per the provincial health order all participants/instructors/coaches and spectators must be screened for symptoms prior to arrival and participation each day and are not allowed to participate if they are ill with COVID symptoms.
- All participants/instructors/coaches and spectators are required to use Manitoba's COVID-19 screening tool before each session. Screening can be completed online at - sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/ -or- in Interactive Voice Response (IVR) format at 1-877-308-9038.
- All participants must bring their own water bottle to the arena. Water fill stations are available. No water fountains will be available to participants or spectators.
- While in the viewing area upstairs the middle row is closed to spectators.
- Washrooms are available. They are sanitized on a frequent basis.

ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE

- Participants will not be able to enter Sunova Arena until thirty 30 minutes prior to the start of their ice rental. Participants must vacate the premises within thirty (30) minutes after their rental has concluded so that the rooms can be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
- When entering the arena all participants/instructors/coaches and spectators are required to utilize the hand sanitizer station located at the front entrance.
- All participants/instructors/coaches and spectators will enter Warren Arena through the main doors (south doors) and exit the arena using the back door past the dressing rooms (north doors).

ICE RENTALS — PRACTICES

- Your dressing room space will be sanitized prior to every use.
- All players and coaches must maintain physical distancing while in the arena, including dressing rooms, and on-ice as much as possible, excluding participants while they are actively engaged in hockey activity.
- We ask that players do not share spaces or supplies at this time.
- Access to the dressing rooms is limited to 13 players per room.
- Dressing room showers and washrooms are permitted for use at this time.
- A Coach/Instructor must be in the dressing room with the participants at all times to ensure physical distancing protocols are being adhered to.
