Spring Registration

- Grades Kindergarten-12th grade
- Opens on December 22, 2025
- Registration closes on February 1, 2026

Little Pacers Kindergarten

- Kindergarten cost is \$50 per player.
- Kindergarten will have their own team and will have practices and scrimmages. Days and times TBD.
- Each player will receive a pinnie for the season and USA Lacrosse membership.
- Club provides helmets
- Players will need to provide their own stick and gloves.



Youth (1-6 grades)

- Cost is \$200 per player.
- 2/3 Practices per week (practice days and times TBD)
- Games and local tournaments on weekends
- Each player will receive a hoodie, shooting shirt, shorts, pinnie and USA Lacrosse membership.
- Club provides helmets



Middle School and High School Teams

- Cost: \$25 pay to play fee to Delaware City Schools
- Registration opens December 22, 2025
- You will register FIRST through the Final Forms portal.
- THEN you will need to register on the DLC website (www.delawarelacrosseclub.com) This is to ensure you receive all team communications for the season, where you will receive the team spirit wear package and sign the code of conduct.
- Current Physical paperwork is due to the Athletic office PRIOR to the first practice (Monday, February 19th)
- Helmets (if needed) will be provided and dispersed on the first day of practice.
- If you have your own matte black helmet it MUST be certified. They will be checked on the first day of practice.

Middle School and High School Teams

Since lacrosse at Dempsey and Hayes is officially a school sport, the Athletic Departments at each school will schedule and pay for officials, enter games into the assigner and Ohio Lacrosse website, provide bus transportation and maintain player and coach eligibility and records. The head coaches are responsible for scheduling games and scrimmages. The Delaware Lacrosse Club remains responsible for supporting the team's needs such as uniforms, apparel, team meals, overnights, volunteers for game days/scrimmages and team communications through SportsEngine (www.delawarelacrosseclub.com).

- You can always purchase your own helmet, and if your son plans on playing in the Summer for a club team, it does make sense that you do so.
- The Club does prefer that your child have a matte black helmet to match his team, but it is not required.

Lacrosse Gear

- The shoulder pads must be designed for lacrosse and must contain the NOCSAE logo and SEI certification mark on both the packaging and the product to be legal for play.

Fundraising Facts

- This year it will take \$80K to operate the Delaware Lacrosse Club
- Since we are not charging more than the pay to play fee at the Middle School and High School levels this year, the Club is losing \$8K in revenue.
- Even though we are an OHSAA sport, the Club receives minimal financial support from the school district to help support the team.
- Dempsey and Hayes will pay for this year: transportation, ref fees, coaching staff (1 MS position)

Fundraising Facts

Not covered by the schools but supported by DLC:

- Cloth/uniforms
- Equipment (Cages, balls, paint for fields)
- Team meals for the MS and HS
- Visiting team meals at the HS
- End of season parties
- Lacrosse association fees and league fees (COYLL)
- Coaches training and certification
- Officials at the K-6 grade levels
- Misc Expenses: website portal, Winter Box Field Rental, storage unit, etc
- The majority of the remaining costs (45% annually) are covered through fundraising and donations
