



What is a Guardian Cap?

- Soft-Shell football helmet cover designed for impact reduction
- Reduces impact up to 33%
- One-size fits all (Youth S – Adult XL)
- Lightweight (7 oz.)
- Available in 5 different colors
 - Black, Red, Silver, Camo & Vegas Gold!
- Lower co-efficient of friction than just a hard shell helmet
- Does not affect the integrity of the helmet
- Waterproof; will not absorb water



- Insulates in hot & cold weather
- Permitted for high school practice & games by the NFHS (National Federation of State High School Association)
- Scientifically tested on the field and in the lab
