To all:

Last summer MAHA Board of Directors passed a new rule to allow youth player movement to the closet rink to the player's residence.

Effective 2017-2018 Season:

Michigan resident players of any age classification are permitted to play for an Association/Club that has the rink closet to their residence, based on Google maps point to point distance, and will not be counted as an out of District player if it is beyond District Boundaries. Player residence documentation must be provided at the time of team registration with MAHA/USA Hockey.

Association or organizations that play out of more than one rink will use their **home** rink as the point for measurement.

Player's wishing to use this procedure must file a Michigan Resident Player Out of District Form for approval to the MAHA District Director of the district the player will be moving to. The District Director will investigate the request and approve or decline the move. The District director will then forward the form to the District Associate Registrar for the district affected. This must be completed and approved before the player is added to any roster by the District Associate Registrar.

Forms will be made available to each Association and District Associate Registrar.
