Carter Albrecht – Varsity Head Coach



Albrecht grew up on the Gulf Coast, playing club and high school soccer for Mobile Bay FC and St. Paul's Episcopal School respectively. Albrecht was named to All-Region teams, the AL North-South All-Star game, the Battle of the Bay All-Star game, and trained and played with Viktoria 06 Buchholz in Duisburg, NRW, Germany directly after graduation. Albrecht works full-time for St. Paul Blackhawks SC, where he has led teams to a State Championship in each of the last two years (U17 in 2021 and U18 in 2022), as a staff coach and as the new Director of College Advising. Albrecht is also the Head Coach for semipro Vloro FC (UPSL), winning the Midwest-West Conference regular season title in 2022. Albrecht has previously worked for Gulf Coast Texans, St. Paul's Episcopal School (Varsity Assistant), Cottage Hill Christian Academy (Varsity Head Coach), St. Paul Academy and Summit School (Middle School Boys and Girls Head Coach), and St. Paul Humboldt (Varsity Assistant). Albrecht holds a UEFA B License (Scottish FA), Premier Diploma (United Soccer Coaches), and is a licensed Talent ID Scout through the UK-based Professional Football Scouts Association (PFSA). Albrecht is currently completing his UEFA A License Assessment with the Scottish FA. Albrecht is entering his second season as CDH Boys Soccer Varsity Head Coach.

Sinisa Vukadin – JV Head Coach/Varsity Assistant Coach



Vukadin grew up in Jajce, Yugoslavia. A highly successful youth player, Vukadin went on to play 16 years of professional football in Yugoslavia, Hungary, Austria, and later Serbia. Vukadin's professional career included stints at high-profile clubs such as FK Elektrobosna (Yugoslavia),

Moving to the United States in 2002, Sinisa has worked extensively on the Gulf Coast, including roles with: Blast SC, Mobile SC, Mobile Bay FC, Gulf Coast United, Biloxi City FC (semipro Head Coach), Port City FC (semipro Head Coach), Bayside Academy (Varsity Coach), St. Luke's Episcopal School (Varsity Coach), Green County HS (Varsity Coach), and D'Iberville HS (Varsity Coach). Vukadin holds a D License from the USSF. Vukadin coached Head Coach Albrecht at U16 and U17 at Mobile Bay FC, leading the team to numerous successes at the state and regional level.

Ben Bailey – Varsity Assistant Coach/JV Assistant Coach



Bailey was born and raised in St. Paul, playing his youth career for St. Paul Blackhawks SC and for four years on CDH Boys Varsity. After high school, Bailey played two years for North Park University (NCAA DIII). Bailey started coaching at CDH in 2019, helping teams in the Summer months for 2019 and 2020, before moving into a role as Varsity and JV Assistant Coach in 2021.
