

Laguna Beach High School Boys Soccer Program 2019-20 Athlete Agreement

The following agreement is to be signed by the athlete and a parent/guardian. The conditions must be understood and agreed upon before the athlete can continue participating in the Laguna Beach High School Boys Soccer Program.

It is understood that:

1. The student athlete realizes that their conduct on and off the school campus can affect their participation in the soccer program.

- An athlete found to be using tobacco, alcohol and/or drugs in the off season will, at a minimum, be required to attend an appropriate educational program to maintain his eligibility in the program. The offending athlete will also serve a minimum of a one game suspension. A second offence will result in the removal from the program for the remainder of the season.

An athlete found to be in violation of the following rules may be removed from the program for the remainder of the season:

- An athlete's behavior, attendance, and promptness during the season or off-season class is found to be detrimental to the program
- An athlete's behavior, attitude, and academic progress is detrimental to the program
- An athlete is participating in criminal activities

2. The student will arrange their schedule, including any non-school activities, so that they can attend all practice sessions as part of the sport. Failure to attend a session without prior communication with the coaching staff with a valid reason will result in a loss of playing privileges for a duration of time determined by the Head Coach of the team.

3. To be eligible for the soccer program, the student understands that it is necessary to pass 20 credits with a 2.0 grade point average or higher. Any athlete absent or missing a period/class on game day, will not be permitted to play that game, but will however be required come support in full uniform.



4. The student athlete will be available for the start of soccer season date along with all training sessions and game dates.

This includes:

- the post-season playoffs should the Varsity team qualify which may take place during the Winter "Ski-Week" break.
- And/or availability for tournaments the team has entered over holidays breaks

** If the student believes they will be unavailable for any it must be communicated to the coaching staff immediately who will then determine whether it is a valid reason or not.

If the coaching staff do not feel it is a valid reason, the deliberate missing of the scheduled soccer activity will result in a suspension from the program for a period determined by the Head Coach of the team.

** A two-sport athlete will report upon the completion of their preceding sports season.

We have read the above conditions. We understand and agree to adhere to the policies of the Laguna Beach High School Boys Soccer Program.
